It's that time of year once again. Exams are quickly approaching and the semester is almost over! Your student should begin to coordinate their move-out process. Wherever they are moving to, planning will help facilitate this stressful transition. If there are issues with this, be sure that they contact their Residence Director immediately.

Please note, additional information about move out will be available on our website, www.housing.neu.edu.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- **April 19th Patriot's Day Holiday**—The Housing & Residential Life office is open between 10a.m.—3p.m.
- **April 21th**—First year student placement form for fall 2010 housing is due.
- **April 29th**—The Fall 2010 placement process begins. Housing assignments will be e-mailed once they are complete. Check with your student to make sure this is complete, as it is a very important part of the process!
- **May 1st**—Applications and deposits are due for *new* freshmen and transfer students for Fall 2010.
- **May 7th**—Senior Commencement.
- **May 8th**—Seniors who are graduating must move out by 11a.m.
- **May 9th**—Summer I move-in between 3p.m.—9p.m. Late or early move-ins must be coordinated with the residence director.
- **Late May**—Students not returning for the summer must move out by 7p.m. Students who are on coop must move out as well by 9p.m. If there are questions or concerns with these move-out times, your student must coordinate with their Residence Director.

Notes: If you are here for Spring and you have assignment summer, you will need to talk to your old and new Residence Director about your move out/move



SUMMER HOUSING

- Summer 2010 housing is still available. Remind your student to submit a \$200 housing deposit for each summer session through the student or parent portal. Go to NUPAY and click on "Make Payment." Select the necessary summer sessions.
- A list of summer open buildings and the Summer I preference form are on the website: www.housing.neu.edu.
- Summer II preference forms will be e-mailed to the students in May.
- Please note the Summer 2010 cancellation schedule below: Deposit refunded without cancellation fee:
Summer 1, 2010 March 1, 2010
Summer II, 2010 April 15, 2010



CURRENT 1ST YEAR STUDENTS HOUSING SELECTION AND PLACEMENT 2010-2011:

- Students should have received their lottery numbers last month.
- First year students, were e-mailed a preference form during the week of March 23rd.
- Students should consider their housing choices seriously prior to submitting the form. The preference form is due April 21th.
- Students should be talking with friends to create their roommate sets if they are interested in living together for the upcoming year.
- Once all the preference forms are received students will be assigned housing in lottery number order.
Please note: the preference form is *not* first come first served.
- Once assigned, students will be notified by e-mail on where they will be living for the Fall 2010.
