#### **Grievance Statement**

On Friday, March 16th at 12:08pm, an email was received by the individual filing this grievance from Nick Beek, on behalf of the Northeastern University College Democrats and the Unleash Northeastern campaign. In part, the email contains the text "The NU Democrats Executive Board would like to endorse Pete Petrin for student body president and Nick Naraghi for executive vice president." While respecting the right of the College Democrats to endorse whichever candidates they so choose, this grievance is filed on the basis that the College Democrats were not given permission to email me. Further, the mailing list utilized for this message is named "Giant Mailing List of Everyone," further indicating that it did not contain specific individuals requesting information, but rather large scrapings of email addresses from many sources.

#### Section 6.1 of the Direct Elections Policies Manual states:

A "Campaign Worker" is defined as a person who performs work, supplies services, or dedicates energy for the goal of electing a particular candidate, at the behest or knowledge of the candidate or their designee. A campaign worker cannot be a voting member of the Elections Committee.

In using access and control to promote the candidates of the Unleash Northeastern campaign, Nick Beek served as a campaign worker in this action. Further, Mr. Beek has served as a vocal worker of the campaign throughout the elections process.

#### Section 6.4 states:

Candidates and campaign workers shall not enter students' rooms or suites for the purpose of campaigning or encouraging students to vote, unless expressly invited by the student.

#### Section 6.5 states:

Candidates and campaign workers will not enter classes in session for the purpose of campaigning or encouraging students to vote, unless permitted by the professor or instructor.

The Manual provides students with safe-havens of their residence and classrooms, free of elections campaigning unless the student or professor respectively allows the campaign to enter that isolated zone. In this case, Nick Beek, on behalf of the campaign, violated this privacy that the Manual has provided me with. This email was received initially in my residence, but could have been received but unknowing recipients anywhere. It is unknown by the filer how many other students had their privacy and rights violated by this action.

#### Section 6.3 states:

Candidates shall respect other candidates' right to campaign and advertise.


#### Section 6.6 states:

Candidates and campaign workers are prohibited from intimidating voters or directly facilitating voting.

Further, when the filer of this grievance addressed the concern to candidate Naraghi on the evening of Sunday, March 18th, among with other students, he provided no remorse and stated that it was part of the strategy of the campaign. The filer was not comfortable with such strategy being used on unconsenting voters, especially as other candidates were put at an inherent disadvantage. The filer of this grievance expressed dissatisfaction and several students

indicated the desire to file a grievance. At that point, Mr. Naraghi applied verbal pressure, warning against filing a grievance or else unwanted consequences may result. He was not specific in this regard, but the filer and the others present did feel intimidated.

#### Witness Statement

At approximately 8pm on Sunday March 18th in the Davenport A hallway, the anon filer, myself, and another student approached Mr. Naraghi about his campaign's email via the NU Democrats email list, and he was very dismissive. Upon further prodding, Mr. Naraghi became visibly irate and combative. He complained about the grievances that have already been filed against his campaign, and threatened us that if any further grievances were filed, there would be repercussions. He did not specify what these would be, but I felt uneasy and threatened due to his violent tone.

Due to Mr. Naraghi's power and positions within his hall council and fraternities, I do not feel comfortable disclosing my personal information, in fear of further retaliation from Mr. Naraghi.
