Project Updates:

- I am currently working with Senator Lothrop on the new Publication process. By shopping all publications in bulk to various printers, the goal is that it will ensure we get a cheaper rate than every group going by themselves. This will allow all groups to be served by higher quality printers.
- I am currently working with Chris LaColla on a Finance Board How To Guide.
- I am currently working with VP Crimmins on the common costs guide, and we are in the preliminary stages of that.
- The Finance Board conducted 4 audits in the month of July. The results are as follows:
 - Tastemakers: Violated 5.3.7 of the SAF Manual. Ordered to return \$1,025 to the SAF Fund.
 - NUHOC: Violated 7.9.4. Ordered to return \$10,197 to the SAF Fund. **Their appeal was denied.**
 - NUHOC Lodge: Violated 7.9.4 and 5.3.7. Ordered to return \$4,612 to the SAF Fund. **Their appeal was denied.**
 - WRBB: Violated 5.3.7 of the SAF Manual. Ordered the return of \$1,200 to the SAF Fund. **Upon appeal, this amount was lowered to \$412.50**
