### A SENSE OF THE SENATE THAT RECOMMENDS THE PROPOSED PHARMACY BE PUT IN THE WHITE HALL CAFETERIA

**WHEREAS** Having a quality pharmacy on campus would provide a great service to Northeastern students, and

**WHEREAS** The recreation center survey clearly shows that students consider the proposed pharmacy a high priority, and

**WHEREAS** The White Hall cafeteria is currently vacant, and

**WHEREAS** Placing the pharmacy in the recreation center plans would delay the pharmacy's arrival on campus by about two years, and


**WHEREAS** Some of the income generated through leasing the White Hall cafeteria space could be used to offset prescription costs to students, and

**WHEREAS** Some students do not get Lane Health Center prescriptions filled because they have trouble affording the cost of the prescribed medication, and

**WHEREAS** If the proposed pharmacy is located in the recreation center, all proceeds will have to be used to cover the operating costs of the recreation center.
