A STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION REQUESTING STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN EACH COLLEGE CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS "Each college has a committee on curriculum appointed by the Dean of the College or elected through established college procedures" , AND
- WHEREAS "To achieve the optimum combination of stability and flexibility, we must promote a decision-making climate that is open, inclusive, and collaborative... [And] as a natural extension of a shared governance philosophy, undergraduate and graduate students must take an active role in the decision-making process by serving on a variety of committees"², AND
- WHEREAS The University, through each college, is constantly reevaluating its academic programs or/and creating new programs to help students meet the new challenge of everyday life, AND
- WHEREAS Students should be a part of any decisions regarding their careers since they are the ones who will be most affected by such programs, THEREFORE BE IT
- RESOLVED That each college curriculum committee should have at least one student as a full voting member of the committee, AND BE IT FURTHER
- RESOLVED That the President of the Student Government Association, in consultation with the Vice president for Academic Affairs, will appoint at least one student to each college curriculum committee, AND BE IT FURTHER
- RESOLVED That in case of an existing organization which represents the students of each College, the SGA will recognize a representative appointed by that organization as its representative in that College Curriculum Committee, AND BE IT FURTHER
- RESOLVED That the student appointee(s) of each college curriculum committee shall be a full time student majoring in the respective college and also available for a period of two consecutive academic quarters.
