A Student Senate Resolution Requesting That the Parking Office Develop a Temporary Day and Overnight Parking Pass Combination for Students, Friends, and Family of Members of the Northeastern Community.

- Whereas:** There are no economical or convenient places for Northeastern visitors to park their vehicle for the day and overnight, **AND**
- Whereas:** Students, during final weeks, bring vehicles to campus in order to expedite the move out of University Housing, **AND**
- Whereas:** Extenuating circumstances arise necessitating the need for temporary overnight parking, **THEREFORE BE IT**
- Resolved:** That the overnight Parking Office develop a temporary twenty-four (24) hour pass for day and overnight parking, **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- Resolved:** That the cost for this pass will be twice the daily rate, paid for at the Cashier's Office or the Husky Card Office and acquired at the Parking Office, **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- Resolved:** That persons with this pass will only be permitted to park in Columbus Lot, **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- Resolved:** That only persons with Northeastern University identification will be permitted to purchase the temporary pass, **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- Resolved:** That this process will be examined in six months for its efficiency and effectiveness.
