EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. SP-04-10Z

Orders that the results of the March 30th Allied Student Coalition elections are considered pending until the Student Affairs Board has heard and ruled on the matter.

WHEREAS, the Student Affairs Board (SAB) of Northeastern University is tasked with approving and monitoring all undergraduate student organizations; AND

WHEREAS, the Student Government's Vice Presidents for Student Affairs and Financial Affairs serve as co-secretaries of the SAB, coordinating all administrative duties of the board; and

WHEREAS, the SAB strives to ensure that all policies and procedures set forth by both the board and the university are adhered to; AND

WHEREAS, questions have been raised regarding the Northeastern University Allied Student Coalition's (NUASC) voting eligibility requirements and election format as outlined in the NUASC constitution in regards to the March 30th elections;

NOW, THEREFORE WE, Allyson Savin, Vice President For Student Affairs of the Northeastern Undergraduate Student Body, and Michael L. Benson, Vice President For Financial Affairs of the Northeastern Undergraduate Student Body, by the virtue of the authority vested in us as the administrators of the Student Affairs Board, do hereby order the following:

1. The results of the elections that were held on March 30, 2004 by the Northeastern University Allied Student Coallition (NUASC) are

considered "pending" until the Student Affairs Board (SAB) has heard and ruled on the case.

- 2. NUASC's officers, specifically including the 2004 presidential candidates, and the organization's faculty advisor are hereby ordered to appear before the Student Affairs Board at 4pm on April 9, 2004 to resolve this issue.
- 3. The Student Affairs Board shall announce a final decision by no later than April 19, 2004 to either uphold NUASC's recent election or to order a new election.
