## A SENSE OF THE SENATE APPROVING THE 2003-2004 NORTHEASTERN UNIVERSITY STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN

SS: WR-03-106

WHEREAS: Nationally, both health care and prescription drug costs have been rising,

AND

WHEREAS: It is vital to keep the price increase of Northeastern's Student Health

Insurance premium as reasonable a rate as possible, AND

WHEREAS: Approximately 4600 students participate in the Northeastern University

Student Health Insurance plan (NUSHIP), AND

WHEREAS: Plan Utilization has increased while enrollment has declined, AND

WHEREAS: An in-depth review was performed by the Lane Health Center Advisory

Board concerning all benefits to NUSHIP recipients, AND

WHEREAS: The Lane Health Center Advisory Board has made the recommendation to

reduce the maximum outpatient benefit from \$2,500 to \$1,500 per policy year and to implement a co pay of \$10 for office visits with preferred

providers, AND

WHEREAS: The reduction of the ambulance benefit from a maximum of \$375 to a

maximum of \$200 per trip, AND

WHEREAS: The implementation of coverage for impacted Wisdom Teeth at 100% to a

maximum of \$2,500 per policy year, THEREFORE BE IT

**RESOLVED:** That the student senate supports the findings of the Lane Health Center

Advisory Board, setting the 2003 – 2004 NUSHIP rates at \$1,178.00.
